




Q2 Tell us about your mental health. Please choose only one.






Q10 Within the past 12 months, you worried that your food would run out before you got money to buy more?




Q12 In the past 12 months, has lack of transportation kept you from medical appointments, meetings, work or from getting things you needed for daily living? Choose all that apply.


Q13 In the past 12 months has the electric, gas, oil, or water company threatened to shut off services to your home?


Q14 In the past 12 months have you had trouble getting child care services?


